A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIDLEY, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF

THE TOWNSHIP OF RIDLEY BY ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR

CHAPTER 260 STORMWATER MANAGEMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in the First Class Township Code, Section

56502 and 56552, the Township of Ridley has the authority to provide for frees and costs to be

charged for applications in various chapters of the General Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 601 and Section 602 of Chapter 260 provide that the Board of

Commissioners shall set the fees and costs from time to time by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board is desirous of establishing the fees for the above sections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the

Township of Ridley pursuant to the power vested in it by the First Class Township Code

Sections 56502 and 56552 hereby adopts the following schedule of fees and costs for the

following section of the Code of the Township of Ridley.

Chapter 260 Stormwater Management

Section 601 and Section 602

Projects under Simplified Approach: \$250.00

Non-Residential:

Insurance Fees: \$250.00 plus \$50.00 per acre/or portion thereof for each acre distributed.

Escrow: \$600.00 for one acre or less

\$250.00 for each additional acre

Residential:

\$250.00 plus \$50.00 per acre/or portion thereof for each acre disturbed

Insurance Fee: \$75.00 for residential property disturbance of less and ¼ acre; ¼ acre or more

Escrow: \$600.00 for on acre or less

\$250.00 for each additional acre

All subsequent reviews shall be 25% of the amount of the initial review fee unless a new application is required as per Section 306 of the Stormwater Ordinance. A new fee shall be submitted with each revision in accordance with this schedule.

This fee schedule shall supersede any fee schedule established previously by the Township.
