



Ridley Township Recreation 2026 Summer Programs

VOLLEYBALL CLINIC/LEAGUE

Ridley High School Volleyball Coaches, players and a staff of former collegiate volleyball players will run a Volleyball Clinic/League this summer. Open to girls entering 8th and 9th grade, the camp will be held in the Ridley High School Gymnasium **Tuesday, June 16 through Wednesday, July 15** as follows:

- Tuesday, June 16 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm
- Wednesday, June 17 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm
- Thursday, June 18 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm
- Wednesday, June 24 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm
- Wednesday, July 1 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm
- Wednesday, July 8 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm
- Wednesday, July 15 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm

There will be 8 (90 minute) consisting of 3 skills practices, 2 team practices and 3 matches. (2 games to 25 and 1 game to 15). Playing time in the set will differ based on the players positions. **Cost is \$100 per player** and each player will receive a t-shirt.

RIDLEY BASEBALL CAMP

Ridley High School Varsity Head Coach Tom Carey along with high school coaches, players and alumni, will conduct a baseball skills camp for ages 7 to 15 as follows:

- **July 6-9 from 9:00am to 12:30pm for ages 7-10**
- **July 13-16 from 9:00am to 12:30pm for ages 11-15**
- **July 20-23 from 9:00am to 12:30pm for ages 7-10**
- **July 27-30 from 9:00am to 12:30pm for ages 11-15**

Campers will work on all facets of the game and will receive instruction to improve their hitting, defense and pitching. The camp will be held at the Ridley High School Varsity Baseball Field (in the event of rain, camp will be held in the Ridley Community Center). **Cost is \$100 per camper.** Campers should bring their own snack & drink clearly labeled. Each participant will receive a t-shirt.

GIRLS LACROSSE CAMP

Ridley High School Girls Varsity Coach Meagan DiCave and Assistant Coach Mara Schnellenbach will hold a skills camp for girls in grades 1 through 8. Each camper will receive a t-shirt. **The camp will be held at Ridley High School turf field (stadium field) June 15 through June 18 from 9:00am to 12:00pm. The cost is \$70 per camper. Campers must supply their own equipment (stick, mouth guard & goggles).**

BOYS LACROSSE CAMP

The camp will be conducted by Ridley High School Boys Varsity Head Coach, Steve Hill and Assistant Coach Kelton Heverly, along with staff & players from the Ridley High School Varsity team. Open to boys ages 5 to 15. Each camper will receive a t-shirt. The camp will be held at the field directly behind Ridley High School. **June 15 through June 18 from 9:00am to 11:30am. The cost is \$70 per camper. Campers must supply their own equipment (helmet, stick, pads and mouth guard).**

RIDLEY BASKETBALL CAMP

The Ridley Township Basketball Camp will run for 4 days from **June 22 through June 25 from 9:00am to 12:00pm** in the Ridley High School Gymnasium conducted by Ryan Bollinger and staff. The camp will emphasize the fundamentals of basketball with individual attention given to each player. The campers will not only provide a fundamental base for each young player, but will also be a fun and enjoyable experience for every camper. Open to boys and girls ages 9 to 14. **Cost is \$70 per player** and each player will receive a t-shirt. **Register early – there is a 60 player maximum.**

USTA TENNIS CAMP

Justin DiPietropaolo from the US Tennis Association will conduct a skills camp at the Ridley High School Tennis Courts **June 15 through 18 from 9:00am to 11:00am for ages 5 to 11 and from 11:00am to 1:00pm for ages 12 to 18. Cost is \$85 per camper. **Friday, June 19th will be used as a rain date in the event of inclement weather.**

GREEN RAIDER SOFTBALL CAMP

This camp, coordinated by Ridley Girls Varsity Softball Coach Brooke Berger Roark, is designed for players ages 7 through 14 and is focused on improving basic skills to help make players successful at the next level. Campers interested in pitching will get specific instruction from local pitching coaches. Each camper will receive a t-shirt. **Camp will be held June 23 through 25 from 3:00pm to 6:00pm at the Ridley High School Varsity Softball Field. Cost is \$80 per camper.**

YOGA CLASSES

All classes will be held at Ridley's Creekside Center, 794 Milmont Avenue, Swarthmore

Beginner Yoga: This class is a slow-paced session that introduces fundamental poses, breathing techniques, and proper alignment. The focus is on building a solid foundation by offering guidance, modifications, and holding poses for a longer duration than at higher levels. Students can expect a supportive environment where they can move at their own pace and learn the language and basics of a yoga practice. **Classes will be held Wednesday evenings, June 3 through June 24 from 5:45pm to 7:00pm. The cost is \$55 per participant.**

All Levels Yoga: An all-levels yoga class is suitable for both beginners and experienced practitioners, offering modifications to make poses easier or more challenging as needed. These classes combine various yoga styles, focusing on linking breath with movement (Vinyasa) or holding poses (Hatha) to build strength, flexibility, and balance. The practice typically **Classes will be held Wednesday evenings, June 3 through June 24 from 7:15pm to 8:30pm. The cost is \$55 per participant.**

~ SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM ~

The Ridley Township Playground Program will begin on Monday, June 15, 2026 and will continue for six (6) weeks until July 24, 2026. The camps will be open Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 1:00pm, excluding July 4th. Camp ends at 12:00pm on July 24th. **Our “Fun Day” will be held on Friday, July 17th from 9:00am to 12:00pm. All campers will report to the Ridley Community Center (next to Ridley High School) on the 18th by 9:00am to participate in “Fun Day” activities. Fun Day Will End At Noon!**

Locations this summer are: Amosland Elementary School, Blackrock Park, Edgewood Elementary School, Grace Park Elementary School, and Leedom Community Hall. The Playground Camps are capped at 70 at each location, therefore it is first come, first served. If the location you wish to enroll your child is full, you may choose another location and/or put your child on a waiting list. **We will not exceed the enrollment limit.**

There will be an experienced senior counselor to supervise each location. Each day will consist of arts and crafts, athletic and non-athletic games. Each camper will receive a t-shirt. **Please send plenty of water and a snack with your child each day. PLEASE BE SURE WATER BOTTLE AND SNACK ARE CLEARLY LABELED WITH YOUR CHILD’S NAME.**

Cost is \$100 per participant and \$70 each additional sibling. The program is open to Ridley Township residents ages 5 to 11 only. In order to prepare for proper staffing, please register as soon as possible. **No registrations will be accepted at the playground sites.** All participants must pre-register. Since our program is an outdoor program, the playgrounds will be CLOSED when the weather is inclement.
